Irish Newspaper Archive

An interesting way of bringing history to life in the classroom is to read newspaper reports from the time. Scoilnet has access to the Irish Newspaper Archive which contains over 60 national and regional titles dating back to 1738. Schools and teachers have access to a full range of OSi maps through the Scoilnet maps initiative. Large scale maps, aerial photography and historic maps are available along with a suite of tools to bring them to life in class. Pupils can compare maps, look at elevation profiles, flood plains, historic monuments, population density, and changes. With so much emphasis on 'locality' in the curriculum, Scoilnet maps are incredibly useful. Several lesson activities and suggestions also accompany the maps to make it easy to use.
